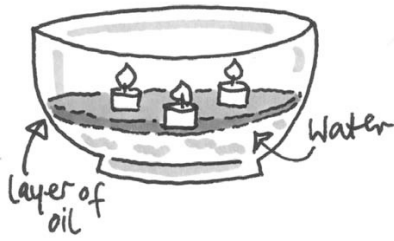


## Candlemas Bowl



You need

- a grown up
- clear bowl, half filled with water,
- olive oil
- a cork
- some string
- an awl – or something pointy with which your adult can make a hole in the cork
- aluminium foil

Pour a good slug of cooking oil into the bowl so that it settles on the top of the water.

Chop a cork into slices and make a hole in the middle with the awl.

Cut up some small circles of foil, the same size as the cork slices, make a hole in the middle.

Cut up some small lengths of string, about 2" long, knot one end.

Insert the string in the cork to make a wick.

Lay the foil on the top surface and insert the wick through the hole (this is to stop the cork burning instead of the wick...)

Float the corks on the oil, wait for the oil to soak into the string – and light them!
